THE GARAGE MASTER CHECKLIST

THE SUNDAY "FLOOR ZERO" RESET

Don't let clutter pile up. Spend 15 minutes every Sunday doing this loop.

- **Clear the "Landing Strip":** Remove all shoes, bags, and boxes from the walkway between the car and the house door.
- **The Bench Sweep:** Clear your workbench surface. If a tool isn't being used, put it back on the [Slatwall/Pegboard].
- **Cord Management:** Retract your [Extension Cord Reel] and [Air Hose Reel].
- **Battery Check:** Check your cordless tool batteries. Put dead ones on the charger for next week.
- **The Final Blow:** Use a [Leaf Blower] or shop vac to quickly clear dust/leaves from the garage floor (blow from back to front).

SEASONAL MAINTENANCE (Every 3 Months)

Protect your home's biggest moving part.

- **Lube the Rollers:** Spray [[Silicone Garage Door Lubricant](#)] on all metal rollers and hinges.
Note: Do NOT grease the tracks!
- **Test the Safety Reverse:** Place a 2x4 board on the ground under the door. Close it. It should reverse automatically when it hits the wood.
- **Seal the Gaps:** Check the rubber weatherstripping at the bottom of the door. If you see light coming through, replace it or install a [[Door Insulation Kit](#)].
- **Heater Prep:** Vacuum the intake filter of your [[Garage Heater](#)] to remove sawdust before turning it on for the season.

PAGE 2: THE DETAILING CHEAT SHEET

THE PRO WASH PROTOCOL

Stop scratching your paint. Follow this order.

THE PROCESS (Do Not Skip Steps)

1. **Wheels First:** Always wash wheels *before* the paint to prevent brake dust from splashing on clean panels. Use a dedicated **[Wheel Brush]**.
2. **The Pre-Wash (Crucial):** Coat the dry car with Snow Foam using your **MJJC Foam Cannon**. Let it dwell for 5 minutes to drag dirt down. Rinse.
3. **The Contact Wash:** Use the **Two-Bucket Method** (One Soap, One Rinse). Use a **Microfiber Wash Mitt**—never a sponge.
4. **The Drying Phase:** Do not air dry (causes spots). Use a **[Twisted Loop Drying Towel]** or a **[Car Air Blower]** to dry the paint quickly.

DILUTION RATIOS (The "Golden Numbers")

Stop guessing. Here is the pro math for your mixtures.

- **Snow Foam (Thick):** 100ml Soap + 900ml Warm Water. (*Requires **1.1mm Orifice** for electric washers*).
- **Wheel Cleaner:** 1:10 (1 part cleaner, 10 parts water) for maintenance; 1:4 for heavy brake dust.
- **All Purpose Cleaner (Interior):** 1:10 for dashboards and plastics.
- **Clay Lube:** 1:64 (or just use soapy water).

THE "NO-GO" LIST

- Never wash in direct sunlight (Hot paint = Water spots).
- Never use "Dish Soap" (It strips your wax/protection).
- Never use the "Brush" at a coin-op car wash (It is full of rocks from the guy before you)
